Job Description:

The truck driver position is expected to work as a valued member of the Supply Chain Team. This job will primarily consist of local vehicle operations involving positioning and moving trucks and trailers on and between company and or customer facilities. On occasion, the deliveries will be required throughout the region. Work schedule is Monday – Friday and home in the evenings. Travel is primarily local within California, and roundtrip within the business day.

The position will require the ability to assist the team to perform an array of functions that may include offloading and processing incoming stock and materials, picking and completing shipping documents, or managing, organizing and retrieving stock in the warehouse as needed.

Essential Functions

- Operate company-owned and leased trucks over 4 tons to facilitate shipping and receiving operations.
- Operate trucks for the delivery, pickup and relocation of perishable products and dry materials.
- Performs Pre-trip and Post-trip inspections and required before, during, and after operation “user maintenance” and provide before, during, and after route documentation.
- Provide outstanding customer service during delivery and pickup operations.
- Operate all Material Handling Equipment.
- Maintain all required certifications required by DOT and OSHA and company safety programs.
- Maintain and protect all property in excellent condition.
- Perform any other tasks assigned to support and improve the overall team operations.
- Maintains truck log according to state and federal regulations.
- Keeps record of materials and products transported.
- Position blocks and secures cargo for transport.
- Cleans, inspects, and services vehicle.
- Operates equipment on vehicle to load, unload, or disperse cargo or materials.
- Obtains customer signature or collects payment for goods delivered and delivery charges.
- Assists in loading and unloading of the truck as needed.

Work Environment: This position is performed both inside and outside including refrigerated and dry warehouse.
